


## Giving Chart

#### Here are three easy ways!

- Set up an automatic payment to CUCC through the online bill payment feature on your bank's website. The bank will send a check to CUCC in the amount and at the frequency you request. It's that simple!
- Set up an EFT (Electronic Funds Transfer) account (called a "Profile") via the GIVE page at

www.congregationalucc.com. Indicate your bank account number, desired frequency and amount of your pledge. The system will automatically transfer your gifts to CUCC per your instructions. By setting up your own profile, you have full control of any changes you wish to make, as well as the ability to schedule special onetime gifts for things such as One Great Hour of Sharing, Strengthen the Church, The Christmas Fund, etc. Again, so simple!

Not crazy about navigating the online giving process on your own? No problem! Feel free to ask us to set up an EFT account for you by completing the form on your Pledge Sheet, attaching a voided check, and submitting your Pledge Sheet in person or via postal mail.
